
Proclamation of 1763

- 1 Massachusetts Assembly
 - No taxation without representation
- 2 Boston tea party
 - against tax on tea
- 3 Philadelphia Congress
 - First Continental Congress
- 4 Declaration of Independence
 - Second Continental Congress
- 5 War of Independence
 - revolutionary ideas; inalienable rights
- 6 American Constitution
 - at Philadelphia Convention
 - republican form of government
 - Ten amendments

① Ideas
